

Stake DAO vsdCRV Compensation Program — Claim Terms

These Compensation Claim Terms (the “Terms”) govern participation in the vsdCRV compensation program (the “Program”) and any claim of compensation under it. By connecting a wallet and submitting a claim, you (the “Claimant”) agree to these Terms.

1. The Program

The Program is authorized by Stake DAO governance pursuant to Proposal “vsdCRV Compensation Program, ID

(<https://snapshot.org/#/s:stakedao.eth/proposal/0xf99c2d8b5124acc9ffcbb78cb53846a86396d3cb08424e770747788e6fc2e1a0>) (the “Proposal”) and is implemented on-chain. It is a voluntary community governance decision and not an offer or undertaking by any single entity.

2. Eligibility

Eligibility and compensation amounts are determined in accordance with the Proposal and at the discretion of Stake DAO governance. Snapshots are final, and determinations are not appealable.

Eligibility is limited to the addresses affected by the 27 May 2026 vsdCRV mint, per the published eligibility list

(https://docs.google.com/spreadsheets/d/1bL4GrmVV8huCbp9IMDYtlmj_qO34eXsPuL0BEFopA). Affected balances are taken at the pre-and post-incident blocks set out in the Proposal (timestamps 1779873467–1779876740). Allocations below 100 sdCRV are excluded. The total pool is 1,535,421.76 sdCRV, distributed 100% in sdCRV on the Ethereum mainnet.

3. Claim Process

Eligible Claimants may claim on-chain via a merkle distribution during the claim window. To claim, the Claimant must connect the wallet associated with eligibility and confirm the representations below.

Claims are made via a Merkle-tree distribution contract on Ethereum mainnet (0x026b5c152234a642878408c23041519495b5f8a5). The claim window opens 29 June 2026 and closes after six months, on 29 December 2026. Unclaimed allocations return to the Stake DAO treasury.

4. Claimant Representations

By submitting a claim, the Claimant represents and warrants that: (a) the connected wallet belongs to the Claimant; (b) the Claimant meets the eligibility requirements; (c) the Claimant is not located in, and not a resident or national of, a sanctioned or restricted jurisdiction, and is not subject to any applicable sanctions list; and (d) the Claimant is solely responsible for any tax and reporting obligations arising from the compensation.

5. Voluntary; No Admission of Liability

Any compensation is provided voluntarily, pursuant to a governance decision, and without any admission of liability, fault or wrongdoing by Stake DAO, the DAO, its token holders, contributors, the Stake DAO Association or any service provider. The rights, claims and defenses of all such parties are expressly reserved.

6. Release (optional)

[Include this section only if the claim is conditioned on a release.] In consideration for the compensation, the Claimant releases Stake DAO, the Stake DAO Association, its contributors and service providers from all claims arising out of or relating to the vsdCRV incident of 27 May 2026.

7. No Advice

Nothing in the Program or these Terms constitutes legal, financial, tax or investment advice. The Claimant is solely responsible for understanding and meeting their own obligations.

8. No Warranty; As-Is

The Program is provided on an “as is” basis without warranty of any kind. Compensation is not guaranteed, and the Program may be modified, suspended or withdrawn in accordance with governance.

9. Taxes

The Claimant is solely responsible for all taxes and reporting obligations in respect of any compensation received.

10. Sanctions; Restricted Jurisdictions

The Program is not available where prohibited and is not an offer or solicitation in any jurisdiction where such an offer would be unlawful. Compensation may be withheld where required by applicable sanctions or law.

11. Changes; Corrections

Stake DAO governance may amend the Program or these Terms. Erroneous or duplicate distributions may be corrected or reclaimed.

12. Entire Agreement; Order of Precedence

These Terms are the binding terms of the Program and prevail over any summary on the website. The Proposal governs the economic parameters of the Program; these Terms govern the Claimant relationship.

13. Governing Law; Jurisdiction

These Terms are governed by the laws of Switzerland, and disputes are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Zug, Switzerland.

14. Privacy

Wallet addresses and claim data are processed in accordance with the Privacy Policy (<https://www.stakedao.org/stake-dao-terms-and-conditions.pdf#page=9>).
